Thank you for your interest in Mushroom Family Learning Center. We were established as a non-profit, nondenominational corporation in 1973. At Mushroom Family Learning Center we believe what happens during a child's preschool experience is very important. By providing a trusting atmosphere with mutual respect between teacher and child, a child is free to grow in social, emotional, and academic areas. Our small student teacher ratio helps our teachers nourish, stimulate, support and recognize the uniqueness of each child. This enables the child to discover the special gifts that lie within them.

Our program year begins in September and ends in May. We offer programming for toddlers and their parents, and independent programming for children ages two through six. Programming for these ages is both in the morning and early afternoon. In addition, we offer a before or after kindergarten program (T/TH 9-11:30 AM or 12:30-3 PM.) We also offer our Mushroom children special program teachers in Music and Movement at no extra cost.

In addition to our yearly programs, we offer Enrichment classes on Mondays, Fridays, and some Thursdays which can extend the day with special programs that have a particular focus. A Lunch program is also offered three days a week (T, W, and TH.) In all cases, children must bring their own lunch to school.

The family is very important to Mushroom Family Learning Center and we have several family events throughout the year where we encourage the entire family, as well as extended family, to participate with us.
